THE SARAWAK MALAY DRUMS FESTIVAL 2019 UNITES THE BORNEO ARCHIPELAGO

KUCHING 2 November – Drums are synonymous with the people of the Malay Straits and Borneo Islands with many variations, rhythms, forms and actions that impact the local community. Through this spirit that Sarawak National Department for Culture and Arts together with Sarawak State Government organized the Sarawak Malay Drums Festival 2019 Tourism Programme which is held on the 1st until 3rd November 2019 at Sarawak Regatta Main Stage, Kuching Waterfront.

Among the main objectives of organizing SMDF 2019 is to create network of cultural arts in Sarawak that is strong and capable of uniting the society's relationship through cultural art activities. At the same time, with the organization of such festival, it will produce a new generation of successors in inheriting various branches of arts specifically the drum arts in Sarawak and simultaneously becoming a part of tourist attraction in this Land of the Hornbills.

Through the organization of SMDF 2019, it will be able to highlight this interesting and unique cultural arts content in various main events and supporting activities provided by the organizer. Similar to previous years, the Sarawak Malay Drums Competition becomes the main content for the festival and definitely to be much awaited by everyone in Sarawak and Borneo islands with the participation of 13 groups battling for the title of the champion.

The majority of participation for this competition are in group category and the participants are not only centered in the Kuching area but come from Samarahan, Simunjan, Daro, Limbang, Sibu and Miri areas as well as from Brunei and Indonesia.

The preliminary or auditions for the competition was held on 1st November 2019 at Sarawak Regatta Main Stage started at 10.00 am to select the four (4) best groups qualified for the finals and compete on the Gala Night which falls on 2nd November 2019 starting at 8.00 pm. The prizes will be handed out by **YB Datuk Haji Abdul Karim Rahman Hamzah**, **Minister at the Ministry of Tourism**, **Arts, Culture, Youth and Sports Sarawak**, alongside **YB Tuan Muhammad Bakhtiar bin Wan Chik**, Deputy Minister at the Ministry of Tourism, Arts and Culture Malaysia in conjunction with the opening ceremony and the performance of Sarawak ethnic drums combination on gala night.

The Sarawak Malay Drums Competition will be judged by jury panel of three persons experienced in Sarawak Malay Drums namely Tuan Haji Yusof bin Haji Buang, Razali bin Haji Yu and Haji Morsalim bin Hj. Bolhassan.

Other than that, visitors of the SMDC 2019 will be entertained by various interval activities such as cultural performance by the young Muhammad Fakhrul Afif and Oscar Neil Gelibat, from Sabah Tati Group who have won the National Folklore at the World Cup Dance 2019 in Altice Forum, Braga, Portugal, on last 28 June.

There are also cultural and arts performance by Cultural Artists from Sarawak JKKN Cultural Group, Apprentice Group of Sri Aman Light of Culture Burdah Drums, El Amil Cultural Group from Indonesia, and other Sarawak cultural arts heritage performances.

To add excitement to SMDF2019, Sarawak Malay Drums Workshop, Exhibitions, Sales of Cultural Arts Products, Demonstrations and Traditional Games Competitions, Cultural Arts Quizzes, Teens and Adults *Tandak* Dance Competition, Children Category *Lan Mengaler*, Theatre Puppet Performance, Sarawak Malay Drums Songs Singing Competition and Drums Playing Demonstration, Layer Cake Sculpturing Competition and many more supporting activities at the main stage and Sarawak JKKN stalls are also held. An estimated 50,000 visitors will attend the SMDF 2019 throughout the three days event.

JKKN and the Ministry of Tourism, Arts and Culture are always aware of sourcing out initiatives to provide added value, reformation towards transformation and becoming the catalyst in the development of the nation's cultural art through initiatives to support such cultural tourism products.
